Summary for Quarterly Report January to March 2024:

The first quarter of 2024 showcased remarkable strides in PPHI Sindh's health-care initiatives, highlighting the organization's steadfast dedication to enhancing public health outcomes across the region. This period was characterized by notable advancements and impactful interventions that underscored PPHI Sindh's commitment to providing quality health-care services and fostering positive community impact.

Key Achievements: Infrastructure Enhancements:

A cutting-edge laboratory was inaugurated in Larkana, further enhancing PPHI Sindh's diagnostic capabilities. Additionally, a new medicine warehouse was established at MCHC Kausar Hospital Khairpur, reinforcing adherence to SOPs and ensuring the proper management of essential medicines.

Healthcare Utilization:

The quarter saw significant engagement with healthcare services:

OPD Visits: An impressive 10 million outpatient visits were recorded, with 6.5 million new cases and 3.8 million follow-up cases, highlighting the extensive reach and effectiveness of PPHI Sindh's primary healthcare services.

Maternal Health: PPHI Sindh facilitated 87,669 deliveries, including 83,762 normal vaginal deliveries and 3,851 cesarean sections, alongside 193,444 Antenatal Care-1 (ANC-1)

visits, emphasizing the organization's focus on maternal health and prenatal care.

Family Planning: With 38,546 PPFP commodities provided and 49,701 LARC services administered, PPHI Sindh promoted family planning and reproductive health, empowering individuals with choices over their reproductive health.

Disease Control and Prevention: Progress in combatting infectious diseases was notable:

Tuberculosis Control: A total of 228,456 TB suspects were screened, with 2,435 positive cases identified and managed, contributing to efforts in combatting this infectious disease.

Hepatitis Screening and Vaccination: PPHI Sindh conducted 1.1 million hepatitis screenings, administered 1.06 million doses of the hepatitis vaccine, and achieved a positivity rate of 5% for Hepatitis-C and 1% for Hepatitis-B, demonstrating significant progress in hepatitis control efforts.

Nutrition and Health Promotion: PPHI Sindh's nutrition services and health promotion initiatives made a substantial impact:

AAP and NSCs: The AAP continued its mission to combat child malnutrition through 950 OTP sites, admitting 49,256 children for treatment. Additionally, 3,036 children were admitted to 17 NSCs, highlighting the

organization's holistic approach to nutrition care.

Health Facility Monitoring: PPHI Sindh conducted 26,463 visits and 174 calls to monitor health facilities, ensuring quality healthcare delivery and effective supervision across different regions.

Capacity Building: A total of 155 comprehensive training sessions were conducted, empowering 3,199 participants with the knowledge and skills needed to excel in their respective roles, further strengthening PPHI Sindh's healthcare workforce.

In summary, the first quarter of 2024 witnessed significant achievements and impactful interventions by PPHI Sindh, reflecting the organization's unwavering commitment to improving public health outcomes and fostering positive community impact.
