





(before and during COVID-19 Outbreak – Jan-Feb 2020 vs Mar 2020)





(before and during COVID-19 Outbreak – Jan-Feb 2020 vs Mar 2020)





(before and during COVID-19 Outbreak - Jan-Feb 2020 vs Mar 2020)



(before and during COVID-19 Outbreak - Jan-Feb 2020 vs Mar 2020)











(before and during COVID-19 Outbreak - Jan-Feb 2020 vs Mar 2020)







Coverage of Different Essential Health Services – by Region

Conclusion



- Despite Pandemic COVID-19 threats and the subsequent challenges, constraints due to imposed lockdown and unavailability of PPE at initial stage for HCPs, PPHI Sindh Health facilities remain fully operational
- Beneficiaries are receiving uninterrupted routine and MNCH services since the begin of the outbreak, despite lack of fully protective PPE for HCPs at initial stage.
- Just before the start of local transmission in Sindh, PPHI Sindh managed to provide PPEs to all HCPs (medics and paramedics) despite issues with availability. Where supplies were short, best available locally manufactured PPE were managed
- Social distancing is being emphasized at all health facilities to minimize the risk of transmission
- Screening desks are established at all Health facilities to separate the suspected cases from other patients by clinical history and temperature monitoring.
- The suspected cases for COVID-19 are being referred to designated COVID-19 response centers
- Overall turnover of routine patients have been decreased during the month of March, 2020 as compared to that of January and February average, with some districts (Shikarpur, Tando Allah Yar, Kambar) witnessing more than 20% decrease
- As per expectation it has been observed that there is decrease in services utilization for almost all MNCH indicators
 including immunization coverage, ANC, institutional deliveries, PNC and Family planning visits
- The highest decrease in service utilization has been observed for family planning clients with more than 40% decrease in some districts like Kamber, Kashmore and Shikarpur.
