Response Activities During Flood '22

PPHI Sindh provided prompt response to recent rain and flood emergency. Numerous free mobile and fixed medical camps were arranged at the affected areas across Sindh. PPHI Sindh ensured establishment of alternate temporary HFs wherever they were inundated or damaged and also established 24/7 hospitals with Labour rooms at Jamshoro and Umerkot.

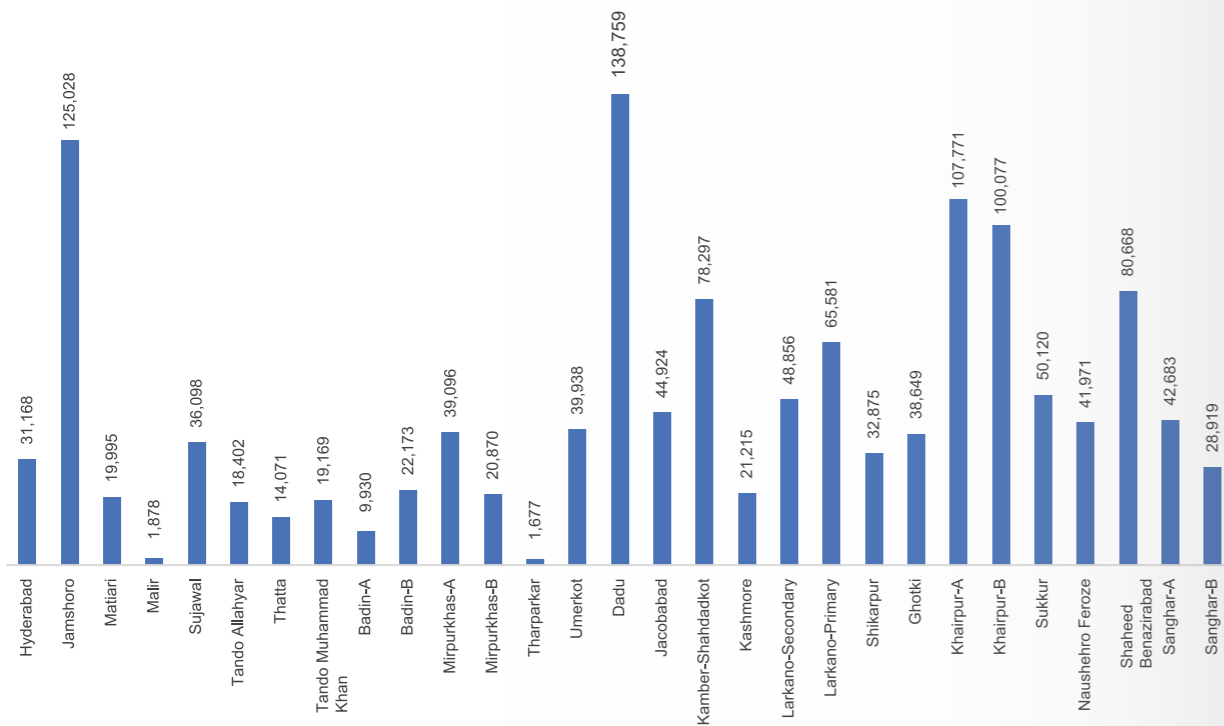

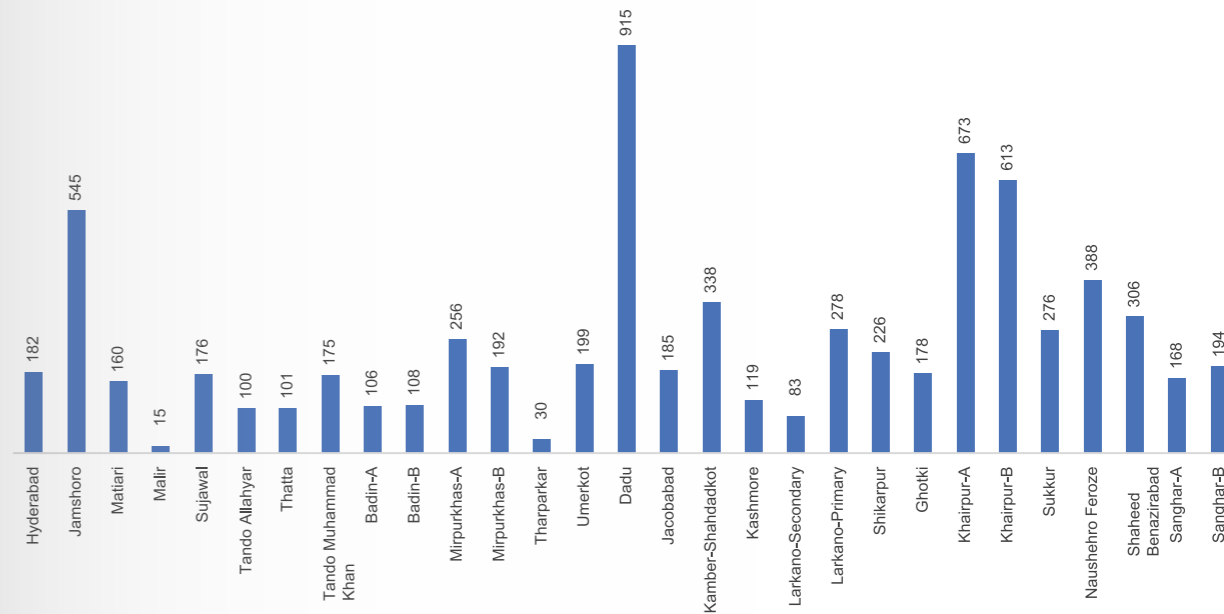

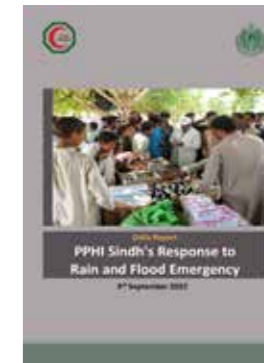

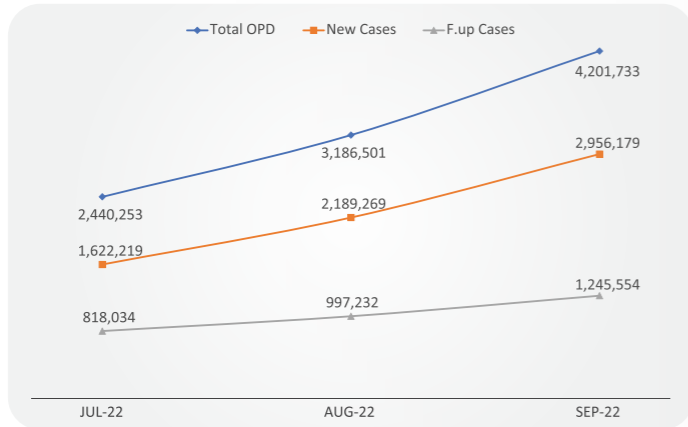

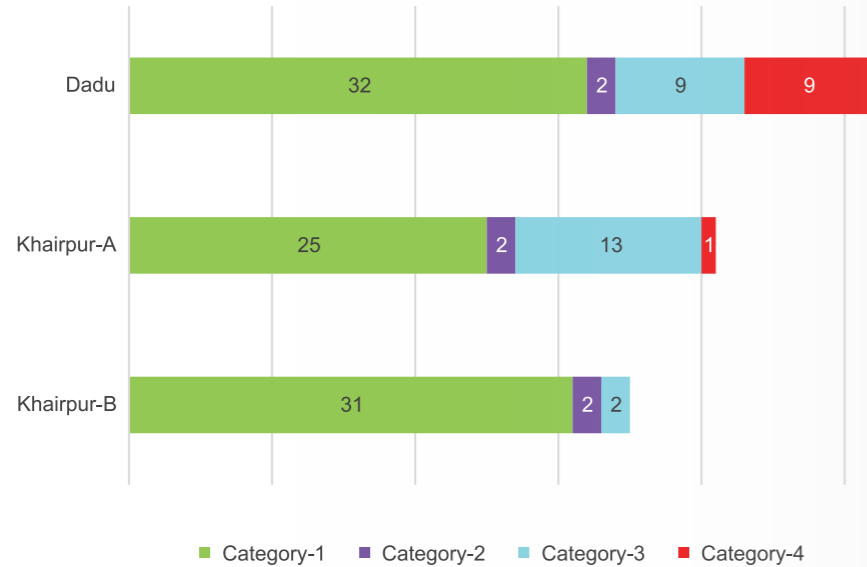
Status of Screening and Admission of Malnutrition Children

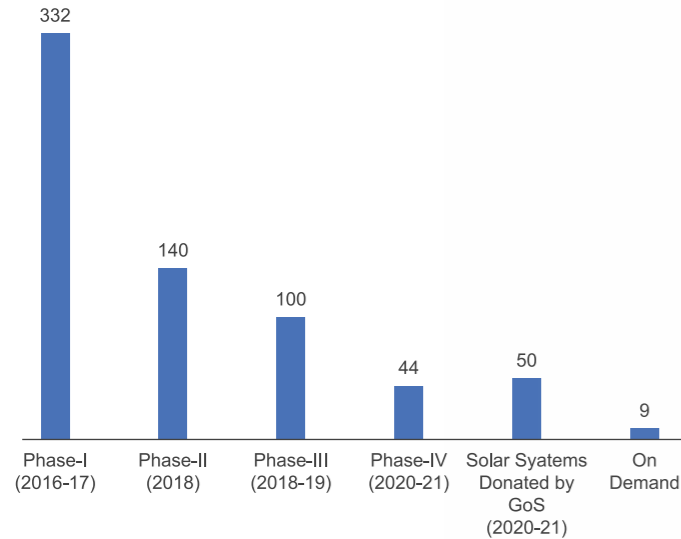

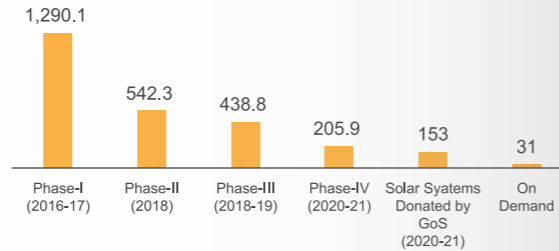

Total Installation Capacity (2,661 KW)



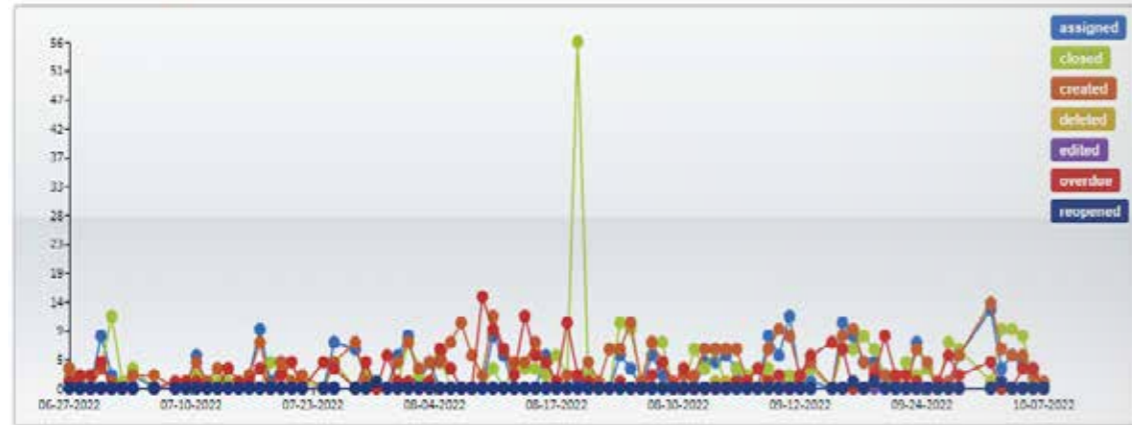
Accomplishments
