





Daily Report PPHI Sindh's Response to Rain and Flood Emergency

26th October 2022


Background

The Sindh government on Tuesday declared 23 districts of the province calamity-hit due to the devastation caused by extraordinary monsoon rains followed by devastating floods. The unrelenting spell of the monsoon which started on August 17 has flooded large parts of Sindh, taking the precious lives of hundreds of people in several districts and injuring a larger number of people. The torrential rains and flood also left millions homeless too.


In response to the rains and flood emergency, PPHI Sindh along with Health Department, Government of Sindh took prompt actions to tackle the situation. Instantly all the PPHI Sindh Regional Directors (RDs) and District Managers (DMs) were directed to be sensitised and take extra efforts to cater to this challenge. All the Health Facilities under the management control of PPHI Sindh were strictly directed to take all necessary measures to face the situation. The measures included availability of staff, availability of medicines, treating the incoming patients and intimating the higher management regarding any outbreaks, emergencies and other calamities. Moreover, field medical camps were established in all flood hit areas that were disconnected from regular communications. The villages affected by rain water and hill-torrents were specifically targeted for medical aid. This whole activity was done in coordination with District Administration and District Health Management to get maximum results in tackling the disastrous situation in Sindh.


Total Free Medical Camps Arranged throughout Sindh










