Redefining Primary Healthcare

Major Activities

- Established 877 desks for screening at 1,238 PPHI Sindh health facilities.
- Dedicated 817 staff members of PPHI Sindh for screening at centres of PPHI Sindh and seven staff for screening at screening desks Outreach of PPHI HFs.
- Disinfected 992 HFs and 183 ambulances with chlorinated water.
- Introduced physical distancing measures at 1,026 HFs to prevent spreading the virus.
- Organised 82 Health Education Sessions by Social Organisers on loud speaker in the community to spread awareness on COVID-19 including hand washing techniques, social distancing and what to do if COVID-19 symptoms appear.
- Assigned 95 staff members including 49 MOs, 35 paramedics and nine Auxiliary staff of PPHI Sindh at Government's Quarantine and Isolation Centres.

Suspected Cases Referred

- From Inside PPHI Sindh Health Facilities
 - ▶ A total of 63 cases were referred to District Health Office (DHO) out of which five cases were refused by DHO. Tests were conducted for 58 patients.
